To the extent required by Americans with Disabilities Act (Titles II and III) and other applicable laws, service animals (as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)), support animals (as defined by the Fair Housing Act (FHA)), and working animals (as defined by UIU's Emotional Support Animal Procedures) will be permitted on campus as provided by law.
