Policy Name: Tobacco Free Policy

Purpose

In its concern for the health and wellbeing of all its constituents, Upper Iowa University has developed a tobacco free use policy based on the state smoke-free air acts of Arizona, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, and Wisconsin.

Scope: All University Stakeholders

Policy

Upper Iowa University prohibits the use of all forms of tobacco products on property owned, leased, rented or properties in the possession of the University. Additionally, the sale or distribution of smoking, tobacco, and unregulated nicotine products on or within UIU-managed property is prohibited. Additionally, advertising smoking, tobacco, and unregulated nicotine products in University publications and within UIU-managed property is prohibited.

Revision History: This policy will replace the "Tobacco Free" policy listed on page 66 of the current Student Handbook.
