** First three years at Upper Iowa University, last 30 hours will need to be earned at an accredited college of mortuary science.

This major is designed as an articulation with the Mayo Clinic, Rochester, Minnesota, refer to catalog, page 69 for details.

Each semester at Upper Iowa University is composed of two seven-week terms during which students normally complete 6 to 9 semester hours per term. Each 3 credit hour course will usually meet six standard class sessions (50 minute periods) per week.

Courses may be certified for Independent Study if your school is accredited and conforms with the criteria outlined in the Code of Federal Regulation 21.4267 (b):

It is a prescribed course; interaction exists between the student and regular faculty; and it is offered when there is no regular scheduled classroom session. It is not a cooperative or correspondence course; it is not a student teaching or flight training course and it does not apply to a graduate level thesis.

These courses must be listed in your college catalog, are an integral part of the student's program and credit earned apply to the student's degree objective. Credit hours should be properly identified on the student's Enrollment Certification VA Form 22-1999. Your school must be able to document that these courses meet the requirements of the law.

The authority for and conditions of this approval are in accordance with the provisions of Code of Federal Regulation 21.4253 as accredited courses.


