An Inspection Visit occurred on December 1, 2010 at Upper Iowa University-Jackson Barracks. The school is a modern facility designed to afford maximum support to the teaching and learning environment. The school is located at 6400 St. Claude Avenue, Building 36, New Orleans, Louisiana 70195. The college occupies the first floor with one office which has approximate 64 square feet with fax, phone and various office machines available and being utilized. Two classrooms with approximately 1424 square feet each and they can be combined into one larger classroom with approximately 2848 square feet. Female and male restrooms are available to students as well as a break room with drink machines and microwave.

This school is approved as an accredited **Institution of Higher Learning**. Upper Iowa University-Jackson Barracks is approved to offer **only** classroom instruction and distance learning instruction **cannot** be certified for VA benefits. The ratio of students-to-instructor is no more than twenty five students per instructor (**25:1**) in both the classrooms and the laboratory. The fire inspection report, attendance sheets and advertising brochures are maintained in the SAA's school folder.

The institution is Upper Iowa University-Jackson Barracks, 6400 St. Claude Avenue, Building 36, New Orleans, Louisiana 70195 and its governing body is the Board of Trustees. The school officials and instructors have adequate educational and work experience qualifications.


