ENHANCE YOUR CAREER AND YOUR LIFE

It's hard to put a value on your education, but statistics show earning potential for college graduates makes sense. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics documents the vast difference in earnings and unemployment for those with college degrees. On average, the median weekly salaries of U.S. citizens nearly doubles—\$809 (\$42,068 annually) for a high school diploma to \$1,334 (\$69,368 annually) for a bachelor's degree. Advanced degrees increase that value to \$1,574 (\$81,848 annually).*

UIU provides paper-and web-based courses that meet your education needs wherever you are. The web-based program allows you to complete your




assignments and exams through our online platform. The paper-based program allows more flexibility with coursework submitted to your instructor by mail, fax or

GRADUATE PROGRAMS

Master of Business Administration (MBA) is designed for the recent college graduate or tenured professional looking to take that next step in their career. Our forward-thinking curriculum is a stepping stone for careers not just in business, but in health care, higher education, athletics and public services. UIU MBA professors are professionals who, working in the fields they teach, bring real-life experience to the classroom. *Areas of Emphasis:* Accounting, Corporate Financial Management, General Management, Human Resource Management, Leadership or Organizational Development.

Master of Public Administration (MPA) provides students with the practical knowledge and skills necessary to excel at leading and managing government and nonprofit organizations. Practitioner oriented and suitable for a variety of occupational fields, this graduate degree helps students navigate the unique political and legal challenges that surround public organizations. Areas of Emphasis: Criminal Justice, Emergency Management and Homeland Security, General Study, Government Administration, Healthcare Management, Nonprofit Management, or Public Management.



Master of Education (MEd) is designed to develop a broad base of knowledge, skills and dispositions that enhance your capacity for leadership. Classes are taught by individuals who have strong hands-on experience teaching in K-12 and working in higher education. Course scheduling is flexible—take classes online and/or at select education locations in lowa. Areas of Emphasis: Early Childhood, English as a Second Language, Instructional Strategist, Reading, Talented and Gifted (TAG) or Teacher Leadership.

Master of Healthcare Administration (MHA) will provide graduates with the knowledge and

skills needed to become effective leaders within the healthcare sector. The core courses are designed to give students a broad overview of the discipline while preparing them to develop their analytical, communication and leadership skills. The

curriculum emphasizes deep institutional knowledge in healthcare delivery, financing, regulatory compliance, critical thinking, problem-solve and professional development. **Areas of Emphasis:** General Leadership, Healthcare Data Analytics, Population Health Management and Senior Living Services.

Master of Science in Counseling (MSC) prepares students to become professional counselors for a unique profession that emphasizes prevention of emotional and mental disorders, early intervention when problems are identified, and empowerment of clients. Counselors not only assist individuals; they are committed to working for social justice in our society and learn to work effectively with a diverse clientele. This program is delivered online. *Areas of Emphasis:* Mental Health Counseling or School Counseling.

TRANSFER/EXPERIENTIAL CREDIT OPTIONS

Transfer your credits

You are able to transfer a maximum of 90 semester credits from four-year accredited institutions completed with a grade of C- or better. Of those 90 credits, a maximum of 78 lower-division semester credits can be transferred. You are able to transfer a maximum of 12-semester credits at the graduate level with a B or above.

Credit by Examination

Earn credit through CLEP, DSST and/or ACT-PEP examinations. Credit by examination is transcribed without charge when your score is at or above the level recommended by the American Council on Education (ACE).

Credit for Military and Civilian Training

The American Council on Education's (ACE) College Credit Recommendation Service connects workplace learning with colleges and universities by helping adults gain access to academic credit for formal courses and examinations taken outside the traditional classroom. Credit will be awarded based upon the ACE National Guide to College Credit for Workforce Training.

Experiential Learning Credit

You know how hard you've worked to get to where you are today—and so do we. To accommodate individuals who have built up experience prior to attending UIU, we developed a portfolio process to determine students' achievements and demonstrated learning outcomes. You can earn up to 30 semester credits of college credit for prior learning experience.

GETTING STARTED

Financial Aid – Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online as soon as possible www.studentaid.gov. UIU's school code is **001893**

Scholarship Opportunities Available – Take advantage of UIU's scholarship options as well as scholarships available in your community.

Military Tuition Assistance (TA) – Armed Forces TA can pay for up to 100% of tuition for members of the military. Criteria and assistance levels vary by branch.

Veterans Benefits – All UIU programs are approved for qualifying learners receiving veterans' benefits, including Post 9/11 GI Bill® and the Yellow Ribbon Program.

Patriot and Military Family Grant – UIU's long-standing relationship with the total military family is beneficial for Department of Defense cardholders. UIU offers two unique grants for the total military family.

Company Tuition Benefits – Check with your Human Resource department to see if you qualify for this option.

Corporate Advantage Partnership Grant – Several organizations have partnered with UIU to provide a tuition grant for their employees and their families.

Payment Plan Options – Take advantage of making monthly payments to help finance your education.
