- Pearson Test of English
 - Undergraduate – 44 or higher
 - Graduate – 48 or higher
- Global Test of English Comprehension (GTEC)
 - Undergraduate – 1050 or higher
 - Graduate – 1150 or higher

Test scores must be within in the last two calendar years.

If a student is transferring from a U.S. institution or have been educated in one of the English proficiency waiver countries (http://www.uiu.edu/international/documents/english_waiver_countries.pdf), the English proficiency requirement is waived.

UIU will also consider other forms of evidence to meet the proof of English proficiency requirement and also reserves the right to exempt specific groups of learners from providing proof approved by the Vice President of International Education and Student Life.
