**Military Family Grant** – Receive a \$250 per undergraduate credit hour tuition rate and \$325 per graduate credit hour tuition rate for all eligible spouses and dependents of active duty, reserve, and National Guard service members.

**Joint Services Transcript (JST)** – We accept up to 78 lower division and 12 upper division credits from your Joint Services Transcript, helping you earn college credit for your military training and experience.
