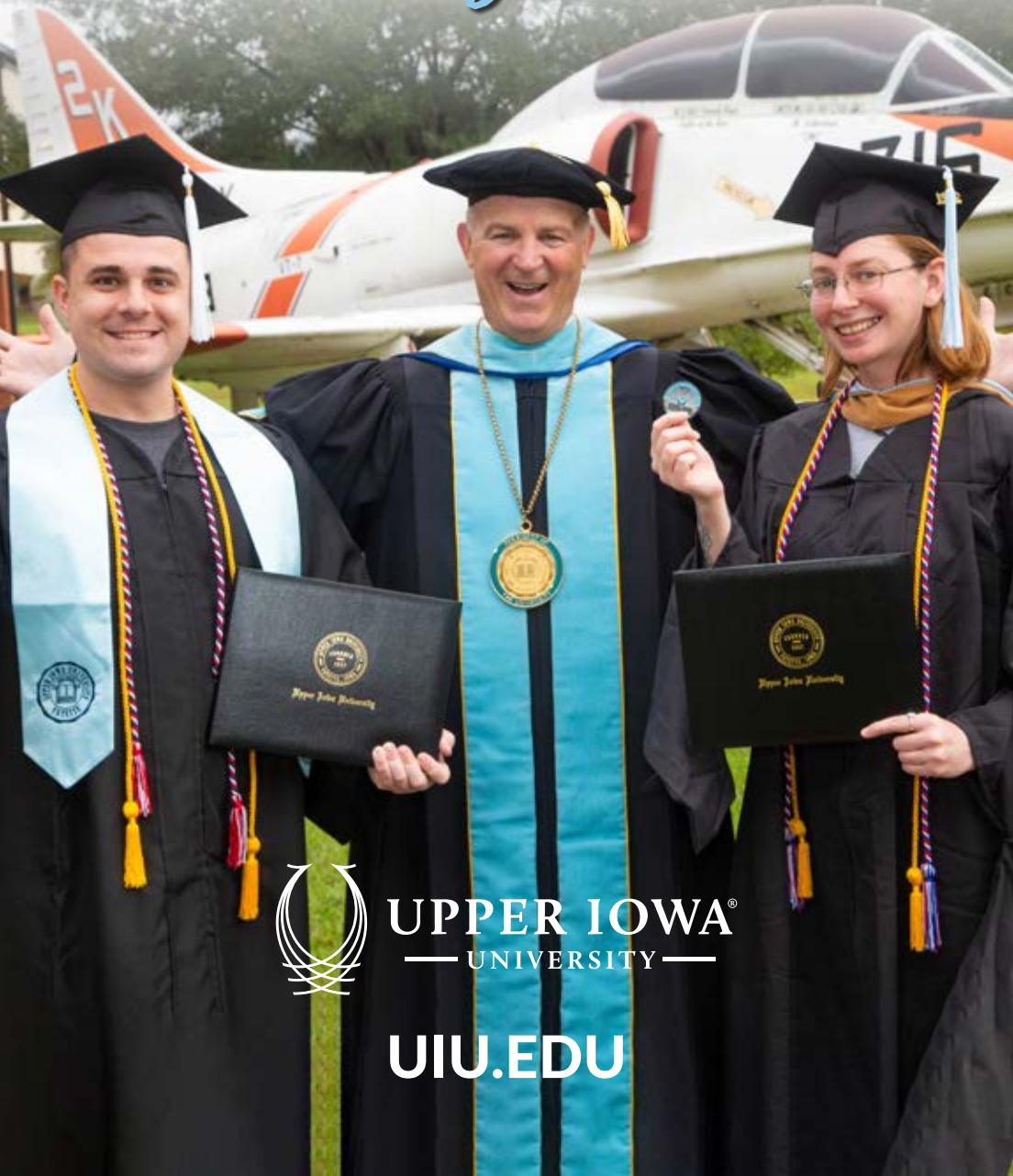

GRANTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

Patriot Tuition Grant – Available to all military personnel (active, guard, reserve, and retired), as well as their family who are Department of Defense ID card holders. Veterans also qualify for the Patriot Grant.

Military Family Grant – offers a reduced rate of \$250 per credit hour, undergraduate and \$325 per credit hour for graduate, for all spouses and dependents, up to age 26, of active-duty, reserve and National Guard service members.

Department of Defense (DoD) Grant – provides a reduced rate of \$250 per credit hour for undergraduate and \$350 per credit hour for graduate, for all current DoD personnel, DoD contractors, spouses and dependents. Your success is our goal!



Scholarships – Once a year, UIU offers the opportunity to apply for scholarships through our Honors & Awards Committee. There are various scholarships available to apply for during that time. For more information, contact your academic advisor.

NAVIGATE YOUR BENEFITS

Upper Iowa University is here to help you navigate military and veterans benefits, financial aid, scholarships and other payment options. All UIU programs are approved by the Department of Education of the State of Iowa and other states to certify qualifying learners to receive veterans' benefits.

Tuition Assistance – U.S. Armed Forces Tuition Assistance (TA) can pay for up to 100% of tuition for members of the military. Criteria and assistance levels vary by branch.

Veterans' benefits are accepted for all UIU programs.

- **The Montgomery GI Bill® (Chapter 30)** – Active Duty benefits are paid directly to the veteran in monthly benefits based on your training time. If eligible, a book allowance is also paid to the veteran. Students are responsible for paying their own tuition and fees directly to the university.
- **Veteran Readiness and Employment (VR&E) (Chapter 31)** These benefits for tuition and fees are paid directly to the university.
- **Veterans Educational Assistance Program (Chapter 32)**
These benefits are paid directly to the student in monthly benefits based on their training time. If eligible, a book allowance is also paid to the veteran. Students are responsible for paying their own tuition and fees directly to the university.
- **The Post 9/11 GI Bill® (Chapter 33)** – The Post 9/11 GI Bill® provides up to 36 months of education benefits for tuition, fees, books, housing and more for eligible individuals. Generally, benefits are payable for 15 years following release from active duty. Benefits are paid based on the veterans percent of eligibility and the rate at which you pursue your degree. Tuition and fees are paid directly to the university. If eligible, book and housing allowance are paid directly to the veteran. UIU is a proud member of the Yellow Ribbon Program. The Yellow Ribbon Program is available to a limited number of students attending UIU's Fayette Campus.
- **Montgomery GI Bill® (Chapter 1606)** - These benefits are paid directly to the student in monthly benefits based on their training time. Students are responsible for paying their own tuition and fees directly to the university.
- **Survivors' and Dependents' Educational Assistance Program (DEA) (Chapter 35)** – These benefits are paid directly to the beneficiary based on your training time. Students are responsible for paying their own tuition and fees directly to the university.
- **Military Spouse Programs** – Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts (MyCAA) is for military spouses of active duty and activated Guard and Reserve servicemembers worldwide. MyCAA provides financial assistance for eligible spouses directly to participating schools or other programs.

Financial Aid assistance is available for those who qualify. To apply, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at WWW.STUDENTAID.GOV. Select the **FAFSA® Form** link and use UIU school code: **001893**

ARMY – Through its many programs, the Army Continuing Education System (ACES) promotes lifelong learning opportunities to enhance each soldier's competitiveness. Its automated tuition assistance web portal allows active-duty soldiers to request tuition assistance (TA) and enroll in courses online. ArmyIgnitED (<https://www.armyignited.army.mil/student>) is the virtual gateway for active duty soldiers to request TA for classroom and distance learning college courses. Through the Army's Continuing Education Degree Program (CEDP) Leadership initiative, UIU offers specific degree paths for soldier in the 14H, 140A and 13MOS series.

ARMY RESERVE – The Army Reserve offers opportunities for selected reserve soldiers to pursue their education on a voluntary basis. Voluntary education plays a vital role in a reservist's career because it enhances promotion opportunities. Voluntary education must be completed on personal time with financial assistance provided by the Army Reserve. USAR Soldiers have complete access to ArmyIgnitED (<https://www.armyignited.army.mil/student>), the virtual gateway for soldiers to request tuition assistance (TA) for classroom and distance learning college courses.

ARMY NATIONAL GUARD – The ARNG Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) program provides financial assistance for voluntary off-duty education programs in support of a soldier's professional and personal self-development goals. Guard soldiers utilize ArmyIgnitED (<https://www.armyignited.army.mil/student>) to register for college courses and review their student records. Additionally, the Guard offers additional programs to help in pursuit of education. Guard students should check with their state ESO to determine eligibility for such programs as the Army National Guard Kicker and State Education Programs, which vary by state.

NAVY – There are two programs available Servicemembers to fund off-duty education: Tuition Assistance (TA) and Navy College Program for Afloat College Education (NCPACE). In responding to a Sailor's need for greater access to higher education, Upper Iowa University is proud to be a member institution in the Navy College Program Afloat College Education (NCPACE). More information is available at uiu.edu/NCPACE. Navy students utilize <https://myeducation.netc.navy.mil/webta/home.html#nbb> to register for college courses.

AIR FORCE AND AIR NATIONAL GUARD (ANG) – Air Force Tuition Assistance (TA) is an important quality-of-life program that provides 100% tuition and fees for courses taken by active-duty personnel. Airmen who have completed an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree with the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) or another accredited two-year program can earn a career-related, four-year degree by completing an additional 60 semester credits. UIU is an approved provider for the GEM program. Airmen use <https://afvec.us.af.mil/afvec/> to register for college courses.

U.S. AIR FORCE RESERVE (USAFR) – The Air Force Reserve offers opportunities for selected reserve airmen to pursue their education on a voluntary basis. Voluntary education plays a vital role in a reservist’s career because it enhances promotion opportunities. Voluntary education must be completed on personal time with financial assistance provided by the Air Force Reserve.


MARINE CORPS – The U.S. Marine Corps Voluntary Education Program provides servicemembers the opportunity to reach their educational goals. As with the other services, Upper Iowa University will evaluate a Marine student’s military training as is posted on the JST transcript and build a personalized college degree plan by consolidating earned credit from military training, college-level testing programs and other college courses.

COAST GUARD – The Coast Guard Institute evaluates Coast Guard transcripts and builds personalized college degree plans by consolidating credit earned from military training, college-level testing programs and other college courses.
