PAYMENT DUE DATE

All Fall semester charges, including tuition, room and board, and any additional fees, will be available to view beginning August 4, 2026. For students wishing to pay their Fall balance in full, payment is due on August 31, 2026. Spring semester balances are due on January 11, 2027. University charges are eligible for a payment plan through <https://pay.uiu.edu>. Failure to make payments by the due dates may result in late fees. Balances over \$1,000.00 may also result in delayed registration, classes being dropped, or denial of future registration activity. Arrangements must be made with the Business Office prior to reinstatement.

COMPLETE YOUR ESA PAPERWORK

Are you planning to return with your ESA this upcoming fall? The ESA registration paperwork must be completed annually, check your UIU email to find updates on the required documents. **Reminder, all paperwork must be completed and turned into the Student Accessibility Services office at least 30 days prior to bringing your ESA to campus.** A new or returning ESA that has not been approved before coming to campus is **considered an unregistered animal and a fine of \$500 will be charged to the student.** Questions regarding the ESA policy? PARKING PERMITS

2026-27 parking permits are \$100 for the full year. Students parked in a campus parking lot without a valid parking permit will be fined \$120. You can find instructions on how to purchase a parking permit online [here](#). Reminder that parking fines will be doubled for second-time violations. Third-time violations will result in a wheel lock. A wheel lock will also incur an additional charge of \$20. Vehicles that have been wheel-locked will be towed at the owner's expense after seven days.
