ENHANCE YOUR CAREER AND YOUR LIFE

It's hard to put a value on your education, but statistics show earning potential for college graduates makes sense. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics documents the vast difference in earnings and unemployment for those with college degrees. On average, the median weekly salaries of U.S. citizens nearly doubles—\$730 (\$37,960 annually) for a high school diploma to \$1,198 (\$62,296) for a bachelor's degree. Advanced degrees increase that value to \$1,434 - \$1,884 (\$74,568 - \$97,968).*

Online

Education Centers

UIU offers academic programs at education centers in communities and on military installations across the U.S. These education centers provide face-to-face classroom learning opportunities in the evenings. Self-Paced Programs

UIU provides paper-and web-based courses that meet your education needs wherever you are. Many courses are available, and you can take up to six months to complete your coursework. The web-based program allows you to complete your assignments and exams through our online platform. The paper-based program allows more flexibility with coursework submitted to your instructor by mail, fax or email and proctored exams. Transfer your credits

If you started your degree at another accredited institution, you can generally transfer credit to UIU for college-level courses completed with a C- grade or better. You are able to transfer a maximum of 90 semester credits from four-year accredited institutions. Of those 90 credits, a maximum of 78 lower-division semester credits can be transferred. You are able to transfer a maximum of 12-semester credits at the graduate level with a B or above.


Credit for Military and Civilian Training

The American Council on Education's (ACE) College Credit Recommendation Service (CREDIT) connects workplace learning with

colleges and universities by helping adults gain access to academic credit for formal courses and examinations taken outside the traditional classroom. Credit will be awarded based upon the ACE National Guide to College Credit for Workforce Training, published by the American Council on Education.

Credit by Examination

Earn credit through CLEP, DSST and/or ACT-PEP examinations. Credit by examination is transcribed without charge when your score is at/or above



the level recommended by the American Council on Education (ACE).

Experiential Learning Credit

You know how hard you've worked to get to where you are today—and so do we. To accommodate individuals who have built up experience prior to attending UIU, we developed a portfolio process to determine students' achievements and demonstrated learning outcomes. You can earn up to 30 semester credits of college credit for prior learning experience.

Financial Aid

Your first step in the federal financial aid process is completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online as soon as possible at **www.fafsa.gov.** Your FAFSA determines you and/or your family's financial needs and is the basis for your financial aid eligibility for federal, state and other financial aid. UIU's school code is 001893.

MILITARY AND VETERANS

Tuition Assistance—Armed Forces Tuition Assistance (TA) can pay for up to 100% of tuition for members of the military. Criteria and assistance levels vary by branch.

Veterans' Benefits—All UIU programs are approved for qualifying learners receive veterans' benefits including:

 GI Bill—The Post 9/11 GI Bill provides up to 36 months of education benefits for tuition. fees, books, housing and more for eligible individuals.

 Yellow Ribbon Program—UIU is a proud member of the Yellow Ribbon Program so military students and veterans can get assistance with tuition expenses if they exceed the highest public in-state undergraduate tuition rate.
