UIU BENEFITS FOR MILITARY AND VETERANS

Military Tuition Assistance Tuition Rate – This special \$250 per credit hour tuition rate, for undergraduate and graduate level courses, is available to all in-service military personnel (active, guard, and reserve).

Patriot Grant is available for all military personnel (active, guard, reserve and retired), as well as their family members, who are Department of Defense ID card holders. Veterans also qualify for the Patriot Grant.

Military Family Grant – Receive \$250 per undergraduate credit hour and \$325 per graduate credit hour through the Military Family Grant for all eligible spouses and dependents of active duty, reserve and National Guard service members.

Credit for your military service (based on Joint Services Transcript).

Transfer up to 90 semester credits from an accredited 4-year institution (maximum of 78 lower-division credits from a two-year institution) with C- grade or better.

Personal UIU advisor available for consultations to help you stay on track with your educational goals.
