Graduate Credits Faculty members with a Master's Degree outside of the field in which they are teaching must have a minimum of 18 graduate credit hours in the discipline or subfield in which they teach.

For Faculty Teaching in Graduate Programs: Instructors teaching in graduate programs should hold the terminal degree determined by the discipline and have a record of research, scholarship, or achievement appropriate for the graduate program.

**Faculty Qualified by Tested Experience:** In cases where faculty without appropriate credentials are being considered to teach coursework, test experience may be used as a basis for determining minimally qualified faculty. If using this option, the “Using Tested Experience as a Basis for Determining Minimally Qualified Faculty” form must be completed and uploaded to DocFinity.
