Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

Take up to 18 credits to fulfill the Major & Elective Requirements.

Choose up to 18 additional credits at Bossier Parish Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill Major and Elective requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:

- Major Requirement – up to 3 credits (SOC 220 or SOC 240)
- Elective Requirement – up to 18 credits
