A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for the BS Degree. Of those credits, a minimum of 30 credits

must be upper division credits. Lower division transfer work from Blackhawk Technical College does not contribute to the upper division credit requirement at UIU.

NOTE: In addition to those to be taken for the major above, another 9-12 credits of upper division courses are needed. Some of this could be accomplished with courses in the shaded general education areas above.

Minimum credits to be taken at UIU:
