A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a Baccalaureate Degree; *up to 78 lower-division college semester credits from Blackhawk Technical College*. A minimum of 30 credits must be upper division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower division transfer work from Blackhawk Technical College does not contribute to the upper division credit requirement at UIU.

Upper Iowa University also offers **Graduate Link Programs**.

These Graduate Link Programs allow students to take graduate level courses as part of their undergraduate degree. The Link courses apply to the undergraduate degree as well as to Upper Iowa University's graduate degrees. The tuition for the Link courses is charged at the undergraduate tuition rate. The opportunity to complete Graduate Link Program courses at the undergraduate level allows students to save both time and money on a graduate degree.

Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:
