Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

Take up to 18 credits to fulfill general education and core requirements.

Choose up to 18 additional credits at Barton Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill general education and core requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:

- Communication (Written) General Education Requirement – up to 6 credits*
- Major Requirement – up to 9 credits*
- Elective Credit Requirement – up to 9 credits in any academic area*
