Take up to 18 credits to fulfill the Business Core, Major & Elective Requirements.

Choose up to 18 additional credits at Central Texas College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill Business Core, Major and Elective requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:

- Business Core Requirements – up to 9 credits (BA 210, MKT 208 & BA 302)
- Major Requirements – up to 3 credits (BA 361 or BA 370)
- Elective Requirements – up to 15 credits
