Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

Take up to 14 credits to fulfill general education requirements.

Choose up to 14 additional credits at Des Moines Area Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill general education requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 14 credits from the following areas:

- Arts/Humanities General Education Requirement up to 6 credits
- Communication (Oral) General Education Requirement up to 3 credits
- Communication (Written) General Education Requirement up to 3 credits
- Computer Skills General Education Requirement up to 3 credits

- Elective Credits up to 5 credits in any academic area
