Take up to 60 credits to fulfill the Peacock Professional Experience (PPE), Major and Elective Requirements.

Choose up to 60 additional credits at Des Moines Area Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill PPE, major and elective requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 60 credits from the following areas:
