Students who transfer to UIU with a completed Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree in liberal arts from Eastern Iowa Community Colleges, will be considered to have fulfilled all lower-division Upper Iowa University general education requirements.

A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a baccalaureate degree; up to 78 lower-division college semester credits from Eastern Iowa Community Colleges. A minimum of 30 credits must be upper-division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower-division transfer work from Eastern Iowa Community Colleges does not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

This program transfer guide is based on the May 2024 course-to-course articulation (UIU 2023-24 catalog & EICC 2023-24 catalog).
