WORK STUDY

Federal Work-Study Program (FWS) is a federal student aid program that provides employment opportunities for eligible undergraduate students who would like to work in order to help pay for college. The student must indicate on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) if they are interested in Federal

Work-Study, and must show financial need (as determined by the Financial Aid Office).

GRANTS

Grants are “gift aid” and do not have to be repaid. Eligibility for grants is determined by the Expected Family Contribution (EFC), as calculated on the FAFSA.
