Students who transfer to UIU with a completed Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree in liberal arts from Hawkeye Community College, will be considered to have fulfilled all lower-division Upper Iowa University PPE requirements.

A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a baccalaureate degree; up to 78 lower-division college semester credits from Hawkeye Community College. A minimum of 30 credits must be upper-division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower-division transfer work from Hawkeye Community College does not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

## Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

### *Take up to 18 credits to fulfill the Major and Elective Requirements.*

Choose up to 18 additional credits at Hawkeye Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill Major and Elective requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

#### **Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:**

- Major Requirement – up to 6 credits (COMM 332 & PSY 310)
- Elective Requirement – up to 12 credits
