## UIU Physical Education, Health, & Coaching Majors 2015-2016 Catalog

The following are also requirements for students majoring in Physical Education, Health, and Coaching:

- The courses listed in the transfer agreement above are for the Physical Education, Health, and Coaching Teaching Major and Endorsement only. If you are considering other majors or endorsements in the Teacher Education program at UIU, you will need to work with UIU to determine an individual transfer plan.
- Students may transfer up to 78 credits.
- Transfer agreements are updated each year. Students should work with an advisor from UIU to make sure they are using the most recent transfer agreement.
- Maintain at least a 2.70 cumulative GPA to be admitted into the Upper Iowa University Teacher Education Program.
- C or higher is needed in Composition I, Composition II, and Speech as well as any EDU, ECE, and SPED prefix courses.
- Successfully pass the College Basic Academic Skills Exam (C-BASE) in Reading and Literature,
   Writing and Mathematics with the following minimum scores:
  - Reading and Literature: 235
  - Writing: 235
  - Math: 235

Each section of the exam may be taken a maximum of three times. (Praxis Core scores minimum in each area are also accepted. Reading: 156 Writing: 162 Mathematics: 150)

- Submit to Criminal Background Checks and have no serious charges in this check.
- Praxis II Test Requirement: State regulation requires students wishing to be recommended for Iowa licensure take a content test and a pedagogy test and attain qualifying scores. Completion of the teacher education program and qualifying scores on the tests do not guarantee a candidate recommendation for teacher licensure. Serious deficiencies shown by the candidate in one or more areas of personal or professional development could result in no recommendation or in additional preparation by the candidate.
- Note: To obtain teacher licensure from the State of Iowa, individuals need to be at least 21 years of age.

## Footnotes on Specific Courses

- EDU 216 and EDU 240 taken with EDU 920 completed at HCC, will transfer to UIU as EDU 110 and EDU 152. HCC students transferring to UIU will also need the following documentation to receive credit for these HCC courses:
  - Documentation of practicum hours to include: log/calendar of hours, contract with agency/school including level and location, evaluation from cooperating/supervising teacher.
  - o Contextual Factors paper completed at HCC.
- Elective Requirement (HCC Course and UIU Equivalent)
  - EDU 216: Introduction to Teaching (3 cr.), EDU 240: Educational Psychology (3 cr.) and EDU 920: Field Experience (1 cr.) = EDU 110: Foundations of American Education (3 cr.) and EDU 152: Assessment and Psychology (3 cr.)
  - PSY 121: Developmental Psychology (3cr.) = EDU 142: Human Growth, Dev/Guidance (3 cr.)
  - EDU 240: Educational Psychology (3 cr.) = EDU 152: Assessment and Psychology (3 cr.)
  - EDU 255: Technology in the Classroom (3 cr.) = EDU 252 Computers and Instructional Technology (3 cr.)
  - o EDU 246: Diverse Learners (3 cr.) = SPED 304 Exceptional Persons (3 cr.)

All five of the courses listed above are core requirements of the Teaching Education Program at Upper Iowa.

\*\* In order for EDU 216, EDU 240, and EDU 920 to transfer for UIU's courses EDU 110 and EDU 152, all three Hawkeye courses must to taken.
