The following are also requirements for students majoring in Birth-Grade 3: Inclusive Settings.

The courses listed in the transfer agreement above are for Birth-Grade 3: Inclusive Settings majors and K-8 Reading endorsement only. If you are considering other majors or endorsements in the Teacher Education program at UIU, you will need to work with UIU to determine an individual transfer plan.

- Students may transfer up to 78 credits.
- Transfer agreements are updated each year. Students should work with an advisor from UIU to make sure they are using the most recent transfer agreement.
- Students must maintain at least a 2.70 cumulative GPA to be admitted into the Upper Iowa University Teacher Education Program.
- A "C" or higher is needed in Composition I, Composition II, and Speech as well as any EDU, ECE, and SPED prefix courses.

- Students must successfully pass the College Basic Academic Skills Exam (C-BASE) in Reading and Literature, Writing and Mathematics with the following minimum scores:
 - Reading and Literature: 235
 - Writing: 235
 - Math: 235

Each section of the exam may be taken a maximum of three times. (Praxis Core scores minimum in each area are also accepted. **Reading**: 156 **Writing**: 162 **Mathematics**: 150)

- Students must submit to Criminal Background Checks and have no serious charges in this check.
- Praxis II Test Requirement: State regulation requires students wishing to be recommended for Iowa licensure take a content test and a pedagogy test and attain qualifying scores. Completion of the teacher education program and qualifying scores on the tests do not guarantee a candidate recommendation for teacher licensure. Serious deficiencies shown by the candidate in one or more areas of personal or professional development could result in no recommendation or in additional preparation by the candidate.
- Current CPR certification for which documentation is provided to UIU
- Note: To obtain teacher licensure from the State of Iowa, individuals need to be at least 21 years of age.
- Students, ask your transfer advisor about other endorsement options including but not limited to:
 - English/Language Arts K 8
 - o Instructional Strategist I K-8
 - Instructional Strategist II Learning Disabilities/Behavior Disorders K 12
 - o Instructional Strategist II Intellectual Disabilities K 12

Footnotes on Specific Courses

- To receive credit at UIU for Field I and Field II from HCC, students must submit the following:
 - Documentation of practicum hours to include: log/calendar of hours, contract with agency/school including level and location (if other than HCC Child Development Center), evaluation from cooperating/supervising teacher. Documentation must include work with infants and preschoolers.

Note: Due to the experiences with children in ECE courses, transfer students will complete EDU 324, the seminar only version of UIU's Field Experience II, instead of ECE 335. (UIU Field Experiences address the Iowa Teaching Standards.)
