Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy and completeness of the above course to course articulation. The office of the Registrar of Upper Iowa University reserves the right to make corrections, additions, and deletions as necessary.

Upper Iowa University may transfer up to 78 lower division college semester credits from accredited institutions, and an additional 12 upper level credits, regardless of the source. A maximum of 90 semester credits may be transferred.

These 78 semester credits include:

- A. No more than nine semester credits from Health, Physical Education and Recreation (HPER) activity courses, including transcribed intercollegiate athletics.
- B. No credits from courses identified by Upper Iowa University as at the remedial or developmental level (except for articulated ESL credits from partner institutions).
- C. No more than 30 semester credits from one-year occupational diploma programs.
