Choose up to 12 additional credits at Kirkwood Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill PPE, Prerequisite and Major requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

#### Choose up to 12 credits from the following areas:

- Creative Expression PPE Requirement up to 3 credits
- Professional Communication (Written) PPE Requirement up to 3 credits (ENG 102)
- Civics, Ethics and Citizenship PPE Requirement-up to 3 credits
- Math Requirement up to 3 credits
- Major Requirement up to 4 credits (BIO 135 or MATH 220)
- Electives up to 5 credits
