Choose up to 16 additional credits at Kirkwood Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill PPE, Major and Elective requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

**Choose up to 16 credits from the following areas:**

- Quantitative Reasoning PPE Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Science PPE Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Civics, Ethics and Citizenship PPE Requirement-up to 3 credits
