Students who transfer to UIU with a completed Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree with a liberal arts core from Kirkwood Community College, will be considered to have fulfilled all lower-division Upper Iowa University general education requirements. Other transfer courses may be reviewed on a course-by-course basis. Lower division transfer work will not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

A maximum of 78 lower-division semester credits may be transferred from accredited institutions to apply toward the minimum 120 semester credits required for a baccalaureate degree.

These 78 semester credit hours include:

A. Up to 9 semester credits of activity courses, including transcripted intercollegiate athletics.

B. No credits from courses identified by Upper Iowa University as remedial or developmental.

C. No more than 30 semester credits from one-year occupational diploma programs.
