A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a Bachelor of Science Degree; with 62 credits transferred from KCC, another **28** will be required at UIU.

Lower division transfer work does not contribute to the upper division credit requirement at UIU. In addition to those to be taken for the major above, another **6-15** credits of **upper division** courses are needed to meet the minimum requirement graduation requirement. These could be completed with courses in the remaining general education areas and with the other 28 credits needed.
