Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:

- Arts/Humanities General Education Requirement up to 3 credits
- Natural Science General Education Requirement up to 6 credits
- Cultures General Education Requirement up to 3 credits
- Business Core Requirement up to 15 credits
- Elective Credits up to 3 credits in any academic area

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
