Other transfer courses may be reviewed on a course-by-course basis.

Lower-division transfer work will not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

A maximum of 78 lower-division semester credits may be transferred from accredited institutions to apply toward the minimum 120 semester credits required for a degree.

These 78 semester credits include:

- A. No more than nine semester credits from Exercise and Sports Studies (EXSS) activity courses, including transcribed intercollegiate athletics.
- B. No credits from courses identified by Upper Iowa University as remedial or developmental (except for articulated intensive English credits from partner institutions).
- C. No more than 30 semester credits from one-year occupational diploma programs.

Upper Iowa University also offers Graduate Link Programs. These Graduate Link Programs allow students to take graduate level courses as part of their undergraduate degree. The Link courses apply to the undergraduate degree as well as to Upper Iowa University's graduate degrees. The tuition for the Link courses is charged at the undergraduate tuition rate. The opportunity to complete Graduate Link Program courses at the undergraduate level allows students to save both time and money on a graduate degree.
