Students who transfer to UIU with a completed Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree in liberal arts from Metropolitan Community College, will be considered to have fulfilled all lower-division Upper Iowa University PPE requirements. However, all students must complete at least 30 hours of general education (Peacock Professional Experience) coursework. If the student has had specific general education requirements waived above, you must meet the 30-hour minimum using any general education course(s) not already applied in the Peacock Professional Experience section.

A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a baccalaureate degree; up to 78 lower-division college semester credits from Metropolitan Community College. A minimum of 30 credits must be upper-division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower-division transfer work from Metropolitan Community College does not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

## Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

*Take up to 15 credits to fulfill Business Core and Elective Requirements.*

Choose up to 15 additional credits at Metropolitan Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill Business Core and Elective requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

**Choose up to 15 credits from the following areas:**

- Business Core Requirements – up to 3 credits (FIN 341 or BA 374)
- Elective Requirements – up to 15 credits
