** Upper Iowa University accepts associate degrees with a major in nursing from registered nurses (must have current license) as fulfillment of its general education requirements for the BSN program. Prerequisites are not waived.

Upper Iowa University offers an RN to BSN program Online. Prior to admission to the nursing program, students must show evidence of the following:

1. Licensure as a Registered Nurse in the state of attendance or a compact state if applicable.
2. GPA of 2.5 or higher and at time of Graduation
3. Evidence of current CPR certification.
4. Evidence of meeting current health and immunization requirements.
5. Completed Criminal Background Check.
