- 1. Licensure as a Registered Nurse in the state of attendance or a compact state if applicable.
- 2. GPA of 2.5 or higher and at time of Graduation
- 3. Evidence of current CPR certification.
- 4. Evidence of meeting current health and immunization requirements.
- 5. Completed Criminal Background Check.
