Available only for students wishing to pursue the Social Work Training Certificate in the State of Wisconsin.

To apply for a social work training certificate, the State of Wisconsin requires students to have grades of C or above in all social work equivalency courses (PSY/SOC 383, PSY 391, PSY 392, and SOC 384) and at least a 2.5 GPA in the major. Students must meet specific standards and demonstrate identified competencies through an assessment process before they will be approved for an internship. This degree plan has been approved by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (DPS). The social work equivalency courses may also be incorporated into Psychology or Criminal Justice majors per DPS rules. Completion of the major does not guarantee social work certification.
