Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

Take up to 18 credits to fulfill the Peacock Professional Experience (PPE), Business Core and Elective Requirements.

Choose up to 18 additional credits at Nunez Community College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill PPE, Business Core and Elective requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:

- Professional Communication (Oral) PPE Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Social Science PPE Requirement-up to 3 credits
- Human Values & Cultural Perspectives PPE Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Business Core Requirements – up to 6 credits (*lower division; see table*)
- Elective Requirements – up to 12 credits
