### **POLICY STATEMENT**

Co-curricular programs that support student learning will engage in assessment by monitoring, supporting, and taking action to improve.

### **PURPOSE**

To articulate the measures and methods used to evaluate the impact co-curricular activities have on student learning.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

Assessment Measures: The means for measuring learning outcomes.

*Co-Curricular:* Learning activities, programs and experiences that reinforce the institution's mission and values and complement the formal curriculum. (This definition was adopted from the HLC glossary.)

### POLICY IMPLEMENTATION

Departments across campus from multiple areas provide co-curricular and extracurricular services and resources. Co-curricular programs and services are designed to provide students with learning experiences which *complement* academic programming. Ancillary programs and services are provided which consider and explore cultural development, wellness, current issues, community service, entertainment and social activities.

Co-curricular areas that support student learning engage in assessment to evaluate their impact on student learning in the following areas: Advising, Athletics, Writing Center, Tutor Center, Career Development, Student Life, Student Activities/Programming, and Residence Life.

Each area evaluates the impact of services offered on student learning.

- 1. A cycle of continuous improvement is maintained (refer to the Co-Curricular Handbook).
- 2. Areas must have defined assessment measures which serve as the means for assessing achievement of co-curricular learning outcomes.
- 3. A reporting structure will be submitted regularly and must include:
  - a. Established learning outcomes;
  - b. Goals:
  - c. Data collection and analysis; and
  - d. An improvement plan.
