

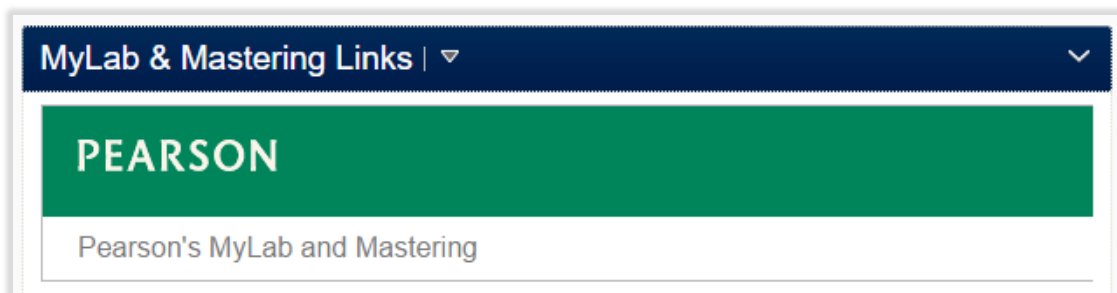
# uiuLearn TUTORIAL

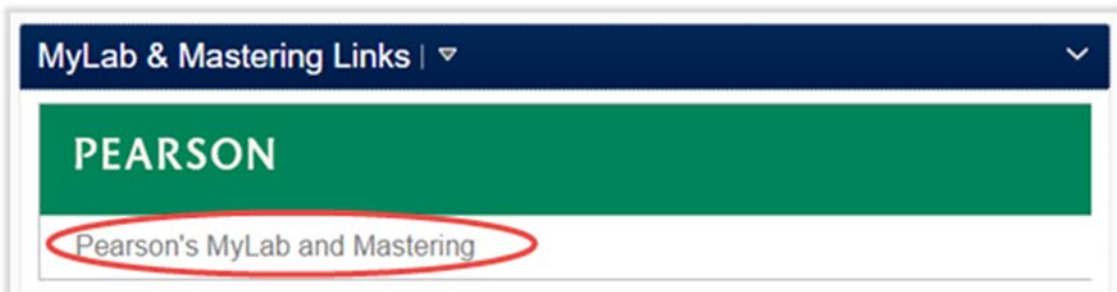
This tutorial covers how to use Pearson MyLabs integration in uiuLearn.

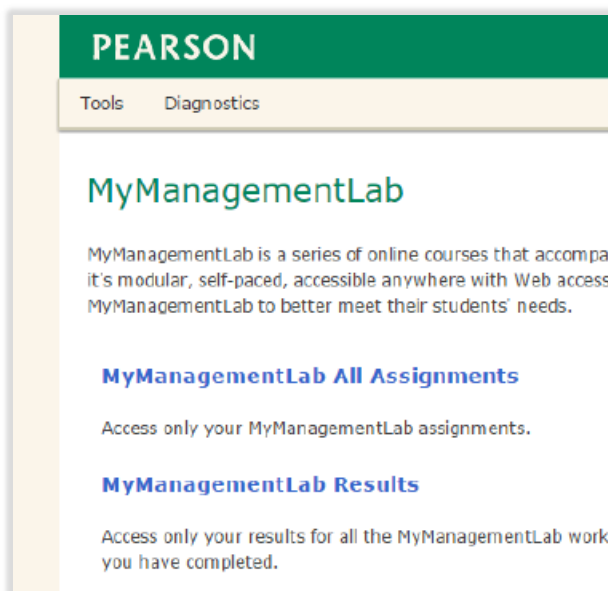
**STEP 1 >** Log in to uiuLearn & go to your course homepage to locate the 'MyLab & Mastering Links' widget.



**STEP 2 >** Click the Pearson's MyLab and Mastering Link in the 'MyLab & Mastering Links' widget.



**STEP 3 >** On the Pearson page, click any MyLab & Mastering content link.



**STEP 4>** The first time you access the MyLab or Mastering course through uIU Learn, you are prompted to agree to the Pearson Privacy Policy.
