A maximum of 78 lower-division semester credits may be transferred from accredited institutions to apply toward the minimum 120 semester credits required for a baccalaureate degree.

These 78 semester credit hours include:

A. Up to nine semester credits of activity courses, including transcripted intercollegiate athletics.

B. No credits from courses identified by Upper Iowa University as remedial or developmental (except for articulated intensive English credits from partner instituitons).

C. No more than 30 semester credits from one-year occupational diploma programs.
