RENEWABLE MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

FRESHMAN STUDENTS

UIU offers four levels of merit scholarships to recognize academic achievement for incoming freshman at Fayette Campus.

- 1. Trustee Scholarship.....\$18,500
- 2. Presidential Scholarship.....\$15,000
- 3. Dean's Scholarship.....\$12,000
- 4. Achievement Scholarship.....\$8,500

TRANSFER STUDENTS

With UIU's transfer tuition scholarship program, eligible students can earn a scholarship of up to \$20,145. Those who do not qualify for the tuition scholarship, are eligible for three levels of merit scholarships.

- 1. Alexander Scholarship..... \$13,000
- 2. Mott Scholarship..... \$11,000
- 3. Albright Scholarship.....\$8,500

WORK STUDY

Federal Work-Study Program (FWS) is a federal student aid program that provides employment opportunities for eligible undergraduate students who would like to work in order to help pay for college. The student must indicate on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) if they are

interested in Federal Work-Study, and must show financial need (as determined by the Financial Aid Office).

GRANTS

Grants are “gift aid” and do not have to be repaid. Eligibility for grants is determined by the Expected Family Contribution (EFC), as calculated on the FAFSA.
