Students who transfer to UIU with a completed Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree in liberal arts from Western Iowa Tech Community College, will be considered to have fulfilled all lower-division Upper Iowa University general education requirements.

A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a baccalaureate degree; up to 78 lower-division college semester credits from Western Iowa Tech Community College. A minimum of 30 credits must be upper-division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower-division transfer work from Western Iowa Tech Community College does not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

This program transfer guide is based on the February 2024 course-to-course articulation (UIU 2023-24 catalog & WIT 2023-24 catalog).

#### Take up to 14 credits to fulfill business core & elective requirements.

#### Choose up to 14 credits from the following areas:
