Students who transfer to UIU with a completed Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree in liberal arts from Western Iowa Technical Comm. College, will be considered to have fulfilled all lower-division Upper Iowa University general education requirements.

A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a baccalaureate degree; up to 78 lower-division college semester credits from Western Iowa Technical Comm. College. A minimum of 30 credits must be upper-division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower-division transfer work from Western Iowa Technical Comm. College does not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

## Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

*Take up to 14 credits to fulfill elective requirements.*

Choose up to 14 additional credits at Western Iowa Technical Comm. College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill elective credit requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

**Choose up to 14 credits from the following areas:**

- Elective Requirement – up to 14 credits in any academic area
