A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a Bachelor of Science Degree.  
With 67 transfer credits from MATC, a minimum of 53 credits is required at UIU.

A minimum of 30 credits must be upper division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree.  
Lower division transfer work from MATC does not contribute to the upper division credit requirement at UIU.

## Upper Iowa University Recommendations for Coursework at MATC

UIU recommends taking **MATH 260 *Business Statistics*** instead of BADM 104, if allowed  
> MATH 260 would transfer as fulfilling both the Mathematics General Education as well as a Business Core requirement.

UIU recommends taking **ITSUP 101 *Computer Information Systems Fund's*** instead of BADM 106, if allowed  
> ITSUP 101 would transfer as fulfilling UIU's Computer Skills General Education requirement.

UIU recommends taking **MKTG 102 *Marketing Principles*** instead of BADM 126, if allowed  
> MKTG 102 would transfer as fulfilling a UIU Business Core requirement.

UIU recommendations for MATC Electives (in addition to the above):

**EPROD 151 *Data Content Management/Implementation*** xfers as BA 222, a Business Core requirement

**HRMGT 198 *Business Ethics*** xfers as BA 225, a Bsns Core & Gen Ed requirement
